

Mr. Beckette received his Bachelor's degree and Master of Business Administration degree from Saint Louis University. He is a 1998 graduate of the Army War College.

MILITARY SERVICE

Mr. Beckette served in the U.S. Army, both active duty and the Army National Guard, from 1971 through 2005, retiring with the rank of Brigadier General. His most prominent assignments were Commander 35th Engineer Brigade (CORPS) and I CORPS Engineer (2 Tours), Deputy STARC Commander, Commander 70th Troop Command, and Commander 1138th Engineer Battalion. He served as a member of the Army Reserve Forces Policy Committee (ARFPC) and Chairman of the ARFPC Readiness Subcommittee, Pentagon 2002-2005. His military awards and decorations include the Legion of Merit, Meritorious Service Medal (2 Bronze Oak Leaf Clusters), Army Commendation Medal (2 Bronze Oak Leaf Clusters), and the Army Achievement Medal (2 Bronze Oak Leaf Clusters).
